## **Notice of Harmonious Development——2009 China Xinjiang Urumqi International Urban Sculpture Symposium**

Xinjiang, where the ancient “Silk Road” crosses, is located in the northwest of China and enjoys a good reputation of real and open folk-custom “museum” with her unique humanity culture and peculiar natural sights as well as the profound history connotation. Urumqi, the capital city and political, economic and cultural center of Xinjiang, is the geographic center of Eurasia and the farthest inland city to ocean in the world. 47 ethnic groups including Uygur, Han, Kazak and Hui, etc. live there. Now Urumqi is the important gateway for China further opening to the west.

Specific arrangement for Harmonious Development——2009 China Xinjiang Urumqi International Urban Sculpture Symposium is as follows:

### **1. Schedule**

- 1.1 July 10<sup>th</sup>, arrival in Urumqi and check in
- 1.2 July 11<sup>th</sup> (Saturday), opening of Creation Camp
- 1.3 July 12<sup>th</sup>—August 20<sup>th</sup>, sculpture creation
- 1.4 July 20<sup>th</sup>—July 27<sup>th</sup>, folk custom collection in Xinjiang
- 1.5 August 22<sup>nd</sup> (Saturday), the Opening Ceremony
- 1.6 August 23<sup>rd</sup> (Sunday), departure.

### **2. Artists & Works Participating in Camp**

- 2.1 Please provide us your 3 works for exhibiting, 1 personal photo and a copy of your passport. Resolution of electronic documents is not less than 300dpi, jpg format.
- 2.2 Please sign the letter of confirmation in time and reply us by e-mail.
- 2.3 All the works to be exhibited during this camp will be selected by Art Committee and approved by Organizing Committee. The production of all works to be exhibited will be organized and coordinated by the

Organizing Committee.

2.4 Certificates and souvenirs will be awarded by Organizing Committee.

2.5 All sculpture works shall be processed in China according to the materials.

2.5.1 Stone sculpture works shall be created on site of Sculpture Camp in Urumqi, and the stone works that are too complicated to be produced on site shall be produced at Beijing Processing Factory.

2.5.2 Metal sculpture works will be produced at Beijing Processing Factory.

2.6 After the works to be exhibited have been confirmed, the models of these works for exhibiting can be carried to China with you, or can be produced in Beijing with your authorization.

2.7 The materials and colors to be used for sculptures shall be declared by artists and confirmed by Organizing Committee. Organizing Committee will provide all necessary materials and arrange assistants to help completing the works.

2.8 Artists shall provide one personal photo, resume and sculpture captions less than 200 words.

2.9 The sculpture works participating in the exhibition will be collected by Urumqi Municipal Government.

### **3. Rights and Interests of Artists**

3.1 Each artist who participates in the exhibition will be awarded RMB thirty thousand RMB (after tax) as remuneration.

3.2 A free trip will be provided for each artist who participates in the exhibition, which is organized by Organizing Committee for collecting information on local customs and culture in Xinjiang.

3.3 Information and works of every artist will be pictured and collected in an album of this event. Organizing Committee will present 2 albums to every artist.

3.4 Organizing Committee will award a certificate and souvenirs to every artist who participates in this exhibition.

3.5 Artists will be invited to participate in the opening ceremony and topic workshop on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009.

3.6 Organizing Committee will reimburse the artists the economy-class round-trip flight tickets from the place of usual residence to Urumqi, and will pay for the expenses of accommodation during the July 10<sup>th</sup> to



August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Extra costs will be at the expense of artists.

#### **4. Intellectual Property Rights and Copyright**

- 4.1 The artists shall be the exclusive original author of the work(s) to be exhibited, and have the copyright and the right of authorship.
- 4.2 The artist shall guarantee that there is no any dispute over the copyright of the works to be exhibited. For any dispute about the works invading any intellectual property right or other rights of the third party, the artist shall bear all legal responsibilities.
- 4.3 The artist shall have the copyright of his/her works while Urumqi Municipal Government has the ownership of the works to be exhibited and the right to exhibit and publish them, and authorizes the organizer of this camp to use those rights.
- 4.4 With the acceptance of this invitation, the artists are deemed to accept and strictly observe all those rules set by Organizing Committee, including but not limit to this document.

#### **5. Unmentioned Matters and Interpretation Right**

- 5.1 The working languages of this even are Chinese and English and all pertinent documents shall be written in both of them. In the event of any discrepancy, the Chinese version governs.
- 5.2 Organizing Committee preserves the final right of interpretation of the terms and conditions for this event. For any matters not mentioned herein, further rules will be instituted and interpreted by Organizing Committee.
